- There are currently 22/23 active deacons in DioCal. but we need 3 times that many. The board is actively working to educate people about diaconal ministry and recruit new deacons. They hope to have about 6 from CA entering school in fall.
- Haley McKeefree is director of School for Deacons. She is working with Bexley/ Seabury on experiential learning. She is hoping to recruit candidates from across the country.

- They are using qualitative data analysis to categorize information from listening sessions and feedback from Bishop's Committees and Vestries. Currently there are 690 comments. 270 comments have not been analyzed. there are also the comments from the Spanish language session, and the online survey.

Bp Marc reported:

- Celebrated Epiphany at DioHause today with lunch and king cakes
- Bp. Marc has begun ordaining people in senior year of seminary.
- There are twelve seminarians coming up for the transitional diaconate by December 2023.

Cn. Debbie reported:

- V+T participation is encouraging. Two congregations from the Diocese of El Camino Real joined the 2022 cohort being sponsored by their diocese.
- Cn. Debbie announced that the Executive Council of the Episcopal Church (DFMS) will meet n San Francisco on the 9-12th February. The Diocese is hosting them on the 9th for evensong with a reception after. the Governance of the Diocese are invited to attend the evensong and reception.
- Absalom Jones celebration will be @ St. Paul's Oakland. Rt. Rev Deon Johnson, Bishop of Missouri, preaching.
- Diocesan staff were given chance to provide information to Search/Transition.



• Task force formed re. assessment formula. Kirsten Spalding chair. Cn. Michele Racusin and Lane Rigley, treasurer, are gathering information from

other dioceses re. assessments. Findings will be presented at Executive Council retreat.

- Updated list of congregations with schools and rectories. 32 have some sort of housing almost half. Most used by clergy of congregation.
- 2/16/2023 there will be a special evensong recognizing Bishop's Ranch (?).

Cn. Hayes:

- Question about ECS Board composition. Cn. Hayes explained canonical requirements and process for exceptions, and made recommendations based on past experience.
- According to the Canons, the Bishop has the authority to set the date for election of new bishop.
- The annual diocesan convention in October nwill adopt special rules of order for electing convention.

- School of Deacons bylaws no questions.
